Dear Mr. Higgins:

This letter describes significant rail infrastructure projects by the Grand Trunk Corporation, on behalf of the U.S. rail operating subsidiaries of Canadian National Railway Company (collectively CN). Pursuant to 49 C.F.R. § 1250.4, a “significant rail infrastructure project” has anticipated expenditures in excess of \$75 million USD.

CN is reconstructing the Baton Rouge spillway bridge in St. Charles Parish, Louisiana. The project is expected to be completed in 2027. The anticipated expenditure is currently in excess of \$75 million USD.
