This Form for annual report should be filled out in triplicate and two copies, the original of which must be the copy containing the mailing label, returned to the Interstate Commerce Commission, Bureau of Accounts, Washington, D. C. 20423, by March 31, of the year following that for which the report is made. One copy of the report should be retained by the respondent. Attention is directed to Sections 1(3), 20(6), and 20(7) of Part I of the Interstate Commerce Act.
- 3. The instructions in this Form should be carefully observed, and each question should be answered fully and accurately. If any inquiry does not apply to the respondent, such fact should be shown on the inquiry by the words "Not applicable." Where the word "None" truly and completely states the fact, it should be given as the answer to any particular inquiry or any particular portion of any inquiry. Where dates are called for, the month and 'ay should be stated as well as the year. Customary abbreviations may be used in stating dates.
- 4. If it be necessary or desirable to insert additional statements, typewritten or other, in a report, they should be legibly made on durable paper and, wherever practicable, on sheets not larger than a page of the Form. The inserts should be securely bound in the report.
- 5. All entries should be made in a permanent black ink. Those of a contrary and unusual character should be indicated in parentheses. Money items throughout this annual report form should be shown in units of dollars adjusted to accord with footings.

4. Mileage, Revenues and Expenses: Show on lines 13, 18, and 19 the miles travelled, revenues received and expenses incurred (revenues and expenses on accrual basis) by cars owned by the respondent during the year, distributed according to type of cars indicated by column headings. If the mileage cannot be distributed separately for loaded and empty cars it should be shown on line 12, and the reason therefore stated in a footnote. If mileage is not available, an estimate should be made on basis of revenue received.

5. Employees: On line 27 furnish the average number of employees, the major porton of whose time is assignable to the cat and protective service operations.
