Surface Transportation Board To Hold November 10 Oral Argument in "Guam" v. "Sea-Land," "American President Lines," & "Matson Navigation"

Surface Transportation Board Chairman Roger Nober has announced that the agency will hold a **November 10, 2004** oral argument in the case entitled *Government of the Territory of Guam v. Sea-Land Service, Inc., American President Lines, Ltd., and Matson Navigation Company, Inc.*, STB Docket No. WCC-101.

The STB will hold the oral argument at **10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, November 10, 2004, in Room 760**, the agency's hearing room, on the **7th Floor** of the agency's headquarters in the **Mercury Building, 1925 K Street, N.W., Washington, D.C.**
